Criteria for participation:

- ✓ For recruitment to these jobs to take place a job description needs to be drawn up to outline the structure and scope of the role
- ✓ The young person has to be gainfully employed for the duration on the programme and be part of your workforce for that period
- ✓ The young person will need a contract of employment drawn up by you which notifies them in writing of their terms and conditions of employment
- ✓ The employer has submitted an Expression of Interest form via the Business Wales website and passed the Welsh Government eligibility criteria.

What happens at the end of the programme?

It is our hope that the young person will gain sustained employment with you and progress onto an apprenticeship.
