Who should attend:

'Directing Safely' is designed to ensure that health and people at the most senior levels appreciate safety.

This one-day course is intended for people with strategic responsibility for determining and implementing effective health and safety management within an organisation. This in turn aims to provide directors/proprietors with an understanding of the moral, legal and business case for proactive health and safety management and to give guidance on effective risk management.

Learning Objectives:

- Understand the importance of strategic health and safety management and its integration into other business management systems
- Understand 'directors' and 'employees' statutory duties
- Identify accident causes and plan for prevention through hazard identification, risk assessment and control strategies.

- Appreciate the significance of performance monitoring for continual improvement of health and safety management.
